great food.

More than anything, I want to focus on conveying the atmosphere, the feeling, and the charm of each place.

On my website, I also plan to use lots of photos, so that you can enjoy the travel atmosphere even more.

Now, there is one small change starting from Season 2.

Until now, the transcripts for this podcast, along with simple vocabulary and grammar explanations, were available to read on my website.

From Season 2, I've decided to gather these materials together on a membership platform called Patreon.

This is because I wanted to create a calm and comfortable place for people who:  
want to study Japanese,  
want to read things again and again,  
or want to take their time and enjoy learning.

I'd like to spend more time creating materials that are:  
easy to read,  
easy to use,  
and helpful for learning Japanese.
